Clothina

With the seasonal changes and spending time each day outdoors, please remember to arrive at nursery with your child dressed suitably for the weather (warm wellies, coats, hats, scarves and gloves). Please make sure they have indoor shoes such as slippers and a change of clothing inside their bags. Outdoors is such a rich learning environment for young children and we encourage free flow throughout the day as well as starting each session outside. Please make sure all clothing is named.

Also for our Little Sparrows (under 2's) if you can make sure your child has bottles, trainer cup, nappies, shoes, slippers, a cot sheet, blanket and their comforter.

Travelling Teddies

Did you know that we have two 'travelling teddies' which are available for children to borrow and share outings, holidays etc? Please ask the duty manager at the nursery gate if you would like to borrow one, to take on adventures or for a sleep over. Snowy is Little Sparrows' Travelling Teddy & Cocoa is Squirrels' & Owls' Teddy. They both have a journey book so you can record some of their adventures and photos. Children love being able to share their stories 'through the eyes of their travelling teddy' and we look forward to hearing their adventures!

Funding

If you're eligible for funded childcare, sign in to get a code, which will go on your funding form, that you are required to submit for each term.

Absences

Although nursery attendance is not statutory, it is important for parents/carers to report their child's absence to nursery on the first day. Your Children's teeth
