School Applications

School leavers will soon hear back about what school your child has got into (16th April 2024) – please inform us of what school your child will be moving to in September 2024. Your child's key person will catch up with you shortly about this and discuss with you, regarding their transition to school.

Refrain from using mobile devices whilst dropping off / collecting children.

Parents and visitors are kindly asked to **refrain from using their mobile phones** when collecting or dropping off their children. If you are found to be using your phone inside the nursery premises you will be asked to finish the call or take the call outside. The welfare, protection, and safety of every child in our care is of paramount importance, we take our responsibility to safeguard children seriously. We have procedures in place which we as everyone to respect and to help promote the safety of the children in our care.

Illness

Please can we remind all parents to adhere to the following guidelines if your child is poorly (please see notice board for the up-to-date public health guidance). For sickness/diarrhoea children cannot attend until 48 hours after the last bout of illness. Please note, **we cannot issue unprescribed medication**. Additionally, we continue our policy of No Calpol, to reduce the risk of spreading illness – if your child is unwell, please keep them at home where they can rest and recuperate so they can return quickly to explore with their friends and teachers.

Parentzone
